**C**licker is the best-selling supportive writing tool, used with children of all abilities in tens of thousands of classrooms. Winner of no less than six major awards, Clicker combines a child-friendly talking word processor (Clicker Writer) with the unique Clicker Grids.

Students can write with whole words, phrases or pictures by clicking on cells in a 'grid'. Grids can be linked so that students can move through them in a sequence, offering scaffolding through written tasks and access to an unlimited number of words or pictures. Reluctant or struggling writers really achieve success as they write in a way that they have never done before.

Words in the grid can be spoken so that a child can hear a word before writing it. Sentences in the word processor are read aloud automatically as they are completed with a period. The child's writing can be printed out or saved in HTML format, so that students can publish their work on the school website.

Clicker Grids are amazingly easy to create - use words from reading books or the current topic in your classroom. Lots of ready-made grids are included with the program, and hundreds more can be downloaded free from LearningGrids.com (see page 17).

Clicker is also a powerful tool for creating multimedia presentations which can be enhanced with digital photographs, sound and video. For example, students can make simple talking books, produce a multimedia guide to the school or create collaborative on-screen presentations.

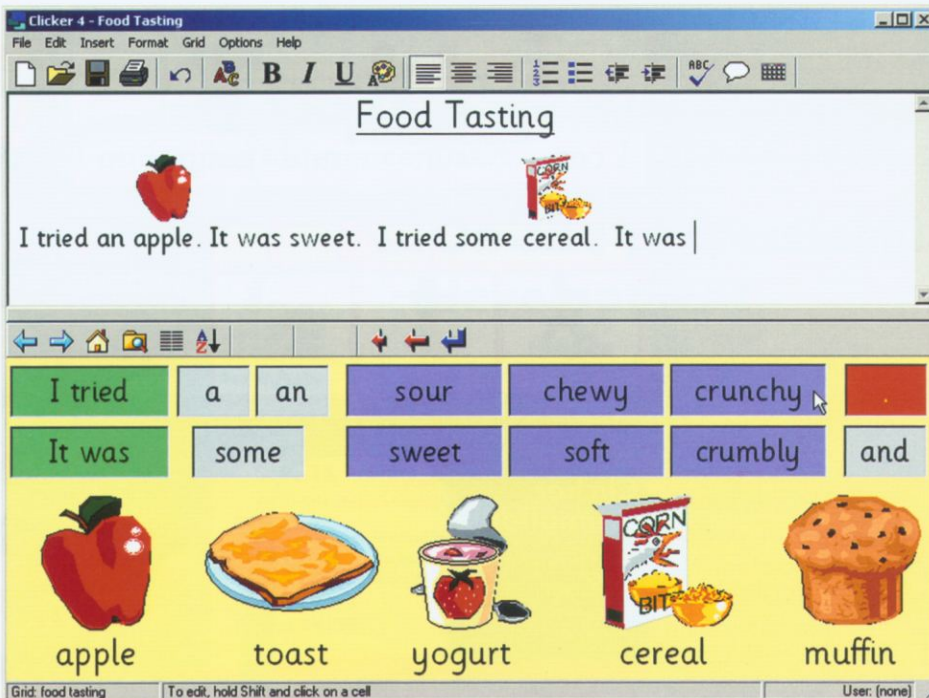
### Graphics

Clicker comes with a graphic library of 1000 pictures, and it's easy to use your

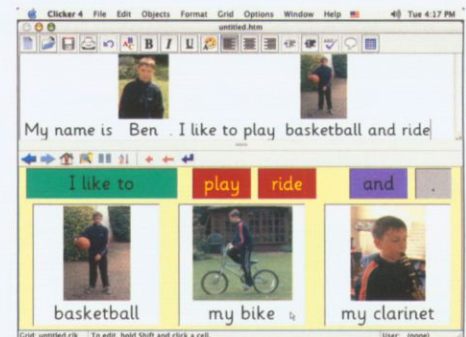
own images - all the main graphic formats are supported, including digital photos.

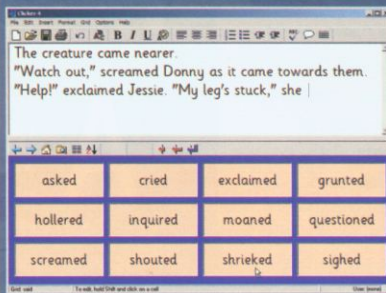

### Sentence building



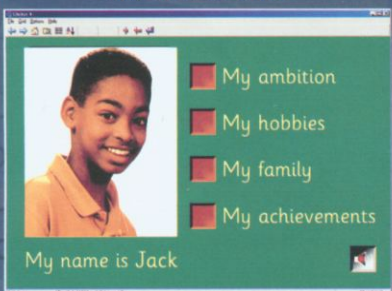
Words can be organized left to right and color-coded to help students to build simple sentences. To listen to a word in the grid, just point to it and right-click (or Control-click on Mac). Then click to send the word into Clicker Writer.

### Word banks



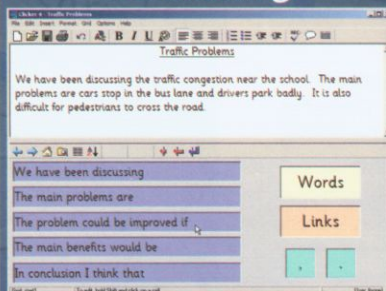
Students can use Clicker Writer like any other word processor. Type from the keyboard but use the Clicker Grids for more difficult words or to extend vocabulary.

### Multimedia



You can create Clicker Grids that work on their own, without Clicker Writer, making them more like pages of digital books. This enables students to create multimedia presentations with digital photos and video.

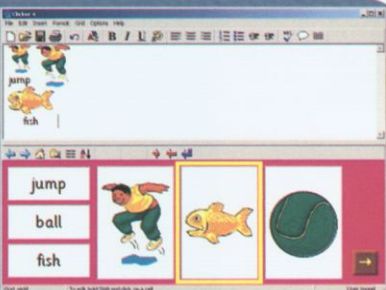
### Scaffolding



Grids can be linked so that students can move through them in a sequence, offering a 'writing frame' or 'story frame' to help structure a piece of writing.

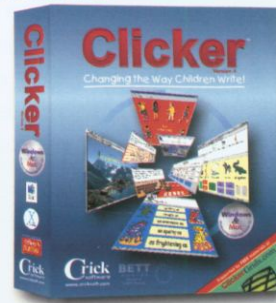
### Access
